In a way, I think that Marceline is like that. Everything happens between the dreamworld and reality in the same present moment. Maybe Pierrot is shooting heroin and in Marceline's world, she sees him blowing on confetti and ribbons. Filth lives alongside magnificence, worlds and illusions crumble down without cancelling each other out.

PEUT-ON ENCORE MOURIR D'AMOUR ? / Lisa Cogniaux

Peut-on encore mourir d'amour ? is about...love. This mysterious, unpredictable, fickle feeling is unnerving for control freaks. According to sociology, its expression is acquired, not innate. It is said to evolve with its cultural representations and current social norms.

Belgium, in 2022, is a patriarchal heteronormative society. As a woman, what can you do if you want to live romantic and passionate love stories yet egalitarian and free of norms?

On stage: two women, a bathtub, flowers and a synthesiser. Judith and Ophélie, played by Stéphanie and Lisa, are friends. They often sing (from Coup de Soleil by Richard Cocciante to contemporary songs and their own compositions).

They refer to pop culture and culture at large (from Love Actually to Marguerite Yourcenar) to talk about love, patriarchy, dead women and living women, political lesbianism and friendship.
